

American League Player's Contract.

Articles of Agreement, between the American League
Baseball Club of Chicago

of the City of Chicago, in the State of Illinois

owning and operating a base ball club, a club member of a League known as the "American League of Professional

Base Ball Clubs," party of the first part, hereinafter called the Club Owner, and

E. J. Collins of the City of Lansdowne in the State

of Pa party of the second part, hereinafter called the Player.

Witnesseth:

That the parties herein agree, in consideration of the mutual obligations herein and hereby assumed by them, severally as follows:

1. The club owner employs the player for the season 1921-1922 and agrees to pay him a salary at the rate of \$2000⁰⁰ per month and an additional sum at the rate of \$3000⁰⁰ per month, said additional sum being in consideration of the option herein reserved to the club owner for the renewal of this contract; said additional sum to be paid whether said option is exercised or not, making the total compensation to the player at the rate of \$15000⁰⁰ per month fifteen thousand dollars The playing season for each year covered by this contract and all renewals hereof shall be as fixed by the schedule for The American League of Professional Base Ball Clubs.
